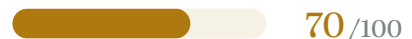

Executive summary

veracly.app is scored against all five frameworks that apply to its visitors across the EU, US, UK and Canada — not just its home jurisdiction. The overall score is 69/100. GDPR / ePrivacy is the highest-priority fix (54/100): critical cookie violations fire before banner interaction. The four accessibility frameworks — EAA / BFSG, ADA Title III, UK Equality Act and AODA — share a WCAG basis, so the same handful of contrast and semantic-structure fixes lifts all four together.

In this report an **issue** is a unique rule, while a **violation** is a single occurrence of that rule on a page.

Copy-paste fixes for the heaviest issues.

CRITICAL

Defer cookies until consent granted

pre-consent-cookie

Move all non-essential cookie writes behind the consent callback. Use the CMP's event API to fire tags only after positive consent.

HOW TO FIX

Implement a consent management platform (CMP) compliant with TCF v2.2. Ensure all analytics and marketing cookies are blocked until the visitor grants consent.

METHODOLOGY

Methodology

- 1 We crawl the site to the configured depth, capturing every reachable internal page.
- 2 axe-core runs for accessibility; network requests are checked for trackers and pre-consent cookies.
- 3 Standard paths are checked for required policy pages (privacy, accessibility, legal notice).
- 4 Each finding is mapped to the relevant jurisdictions via the rules engine, then weighted.
- 5 Check for EU AI Act (Article 50) transparency signals — conversational-AI / chatbot widgets and an AI-use notice — and compute a transparency-readiness score.

DETECTION SCOPE

This scan detects **client-side** tracking only.

The histogram on each scorecard shows the **raw count** of instances per rule.
